HAWS Positions: Looking for more involvement with H.A.? Then service with the HAWS board may be right for YOU! Our nominations committee is continuing to screen applications, interview, and recommend candidates to join the board. - Vice-Treasurer: This position serves to support the Treasurer in all HAWS financial matters including budgeting, tax filing, supervising bank accounts, and assessing the financial status of this fellowship.
- Non-Addict Advisor: This is someone who <u>is not</u> a member of H.A. They may be an expert in recovery fellowships, non-profits, or possess various business skills that they wish to volunteer for the good of H.A.
- Heroin Addict Advisor: This is someone who <u>is</u> a member of H.A. This person will utilize their experience with H.A. and 12 step service to advise the board.
- Public Information Chair: This position is for a member of H.A. who will work with public information at the world level. The efforts of Public Information can be best summarized as taking actions to increase the general population's awareness and accessibility of Heroin Anonymous.
- 3x At-large Voting Members: This position is for new members to the board, its sole function is to show up and help us to discuss and vote on decisions, eventually these members join other committees and may be asked to fill other roles. For example, for one of these spots we are looking for someone with experience in intellectual property or literature writing.

Personal Story: McKenzie C. Green Bay, WI

Growing up I had to watch my father struggle with addiction. I thought he was a monster. Through my adolescent years, I seen how drugs and alcohol affected people's lives and how addicts choose them above all. I hated it but I also took after my dad and followed in his footsteps.

From the young age of 13 I became addicted to opiates, and that went on for 16 years on and off the wagon. At the age of 16, I tried heroin and the feeling was euphoric, like fireworks in my body. Until I got dopesick for the first time. Then I prayed to God to relieve me from my drug addiction. From the endless battle of despair and misconception, of making broken promises to my kids, I needed something to save me.

From there I found Heroin Anonymous and the 12 Steps. My life was forever changed for the good. I put my hand on the hot stove over and over again knowing it would burn me every time, but that was the insanity of my addiction. I finally admitted I was powerless over drugs and alcohol, that my life was unmanageable, and from there on out God was on my side and I lived on his will and not my own selfish will run riot. All the 12 Steps have changed my life and for that I am forever grateful.

I am going on two years sober and with this program and a spiritual foundation I will never go back. I am recovered. I now sponsor many women and spread the message as much as I can. I on the daily live in Steps 10, 11, and 12 and recommend this to anyone. I hope my works encourage many people to give this program a chance.

Personal Story: Ben S. The Psychic Transformation Group, Akron, OH.

My name is Ben S. I'm 35 years old, I have an amazing sponsor, and some great sponsees. I live in Akron, Ohio, the birthplace of A.A. and the 12 Steps! These Steps and the Fellowship have made my life worth living. They've given me purpose, freedom, and my sanity back.

My story isn't unique. I, like many of you, sacrificed my beliefs and morals to stay loaded around the clock. I've been to a lot of jails, prisons, rehabs, detoxes, and the psych ward. I always wanted so badly to stay sober when I left these places but I had no foundation of recovery to stand on. I've spent more than half of my life self-medicating to numb the emotional and physical pain I felt.

I wasn't content living that way. I tried to end my life on multiple occasions, but God had other plans. Because I wasn't treating my disease, the mental obsession always got the best of me. Every time I put a substance in my body, I couldn't stop, telling myself over and over again I'll just do one. One was never enough for me. My spiritual malady had to be overcome. I've found heartfelt prayer to be extremely helpful.

The only reason I'm even willing to write this story is because my

Higher Power did for me what I could never do for myself. He has restored

my sanity and removed the desire to use. That was a miracle for me! I had tried every method except the 12 Steps to no avail. When I sincerely applied myself to completing the life began Steps, my to show improvement. immediate Ιf you're reading this today and you haven't finished your Steps, you should find a solid sponsor and get it done.

Your life will never be the same for the most wonderful reasons.

I'm no longer crippled by fear. I get to spend time with the people I love. My family and friends actually enjoy having me around, it's such a blessing. I've given them so many reasons to write me off or disown me throughout my addiction. It took a lot of time, patience, and effort to get here.

Since I've been through my Steps, I now get to help others get through their Steps. I'm involved on every level of service from local meetings all the way to the world service. I do these things because this program literally saved my life! If we don't put forth the effort to do service work, there will be no Heroin Anonymous. I could never repay this wonderful gift I have been given. I will do my best to help the next person complete these Steps so that they may help others because that's what the 12th Step tells us to do. The most wonderful moment of my recovery was when my sponsee made it through his Steps.

Then he told his story and brought his own sponsee with him to the meeting. I've never experienced such hope and gratitude as I did in that moment. It is truly a moment I will cherish until my last breath. God willing I have more of those to come.

If you ever get the opportunity to attend a convention or a spiritual retreat, don't pass it up. It's taught me that the disease is the same no matter where you live and the solution is the same no matter what demons you're fighting. None of us are alone. I've met so many beautiful souls from all over to share this journey with. Material things don't hold as much value as the true friends I've found and the relationships we've developed in these rooms. As long as you trust God and clean house, your life will improve. Live one day at a time and if it gets tough, live one moment at a time. All the corny cliches will make sense later.
